The North-European Energy Cluster (N-EEC) is a joint action initiated by three separate EU projects in the northern peripheral regions of Europe, i.e. Renovation Center funded by Inter-reg Botnia-Atlantica, e-Lighthouse funded by the Northern Periphery and Arctic Programme (NPA) and ICNB (Increasing Competence in Northern Building) funded by Interreg Nord.

Lead partners of each of the three projects and other key partners form the N-EEC project consortium, which is financed by NPA. The core idea in N-EEC is to gather the strengths and best practices from each ongoing project and create added value by arranging several joint events on energy efficiency and retrofitting of buildings.
